



## *Six Senses Shaharut, Israel*

### *Biblical Heritage of Ancient Negev Desert's Arava Valley*

*Fascinating, enchanting and of biblical proportions, the Negev Desert is the epitome of desert landscapes. It is on this boundless horizon often described as the nexus of heaven and earth that Six Senses Shaharut is nestled into a dramatic cliff. It is at one with the almost-supernatural panorama, where sunsets meld into the orange dunes to become an inky sky scattered with stardust. This inspired location named Shaharut, which translates as the moment just before dawn, adds yet another dimension to the portfolio of incredible natural settings that Six Senses Hotels Resorts Spas calls home. History abounds in this region which was home to the ancient tribe of fascinating people known as Midianites.*



## LOCATION

Located in the south of the Negev Desert, which covers more than half of Israel, is the Arava Valley and the small community of Shaharut, where traditional desert hospitality is expressed by generosity of spirit. This is Six Senses Shaharut, comprising just 60 suites and pool villas occupying a total footprint of approximately 46 acres and including a Six Senses Spa.

## SUITES (15)

Suites measure a generous 495 square feet (46 square meters) with 150 square feet (12 square meters) of outdoor space; and offer Negev Desert and Arava Valley as well as Edom Mountains views.

## PANORAMA SUITES (27)

Panorama Suites present a sizeable 495 square feet (46 square meters) with 150 square feet (12 square meters) outdoor space and offer panoramic 180-degree views of the Negev Desert and Arava Valley.

## POOL SUITES (6)

Pool Suites offer an extensive 495 square feet (46 square meters) with 150 square feet (12 square meters) of outdoor space and present diverse views of the Arava Valley.

## PANORAMA POOL VILLAS (10)

Villas measure 1,075 square feet (100 square meters) plus a 269 square foot (25 square meter) outdoor patio with a dining area and a private pool. Separate bedroom and sitting room. Bathroom comes with a double vanity and an outside shower. Panoramic desert landscape views of Edom Mountains and Negev Desert.

## PANORAMA TWO-BEDROOM POOL VILLA (1)

This villa measures 1,614 square feet (150 square meters) with a 322 square feet (30 square meters) outdoor patio with a dining area and a private pool. It consists of a panorama pool villa and an adjacent suite. Enjoy stunning Edom Mountains and Negev Desert views

## THE PRIVATE RESERVE (1)

The Private Reserve is a three-bedroom retreat with an indoor living space of 3,230 square feet (300 square meters) and 3,700 square feet (344 square meters) of outdoor living area which includes a 775 square foot (72 square meter) pool. It also includes a spa treatment room, steam room, private fitness plus a fully-equipped and semi-outdoor Boffi kitchen.

## DINING

Six Senses Shahrut offers a fresh, evolutive and creative cuisine, combining the best of Israeli and Mediterranean cuisines that embrace the Six Senses culinary philosophy: It's all about local, fresh and seasonal. Fresh seasonal ingredients are harvested from the resort's own organic gardens when possible, and from local farmers at the nearby kibbutzim.

### Midian - Main Restaurant

With indoor and outdoor seating, the restaurant's show kitchen and taboon oven produces progressive ethnic cuisine with Mediterranean and Israeli influence.

## EXPERIENCES

The resort's many on-site attractions are diverse and out-of-the-ordinary in the truest Six Senses tradition. A desert activity center incorporates the fascinating Earth Lab, where the property showcases its sustainability initiatives to reduce consumption, produce locally and support communities and ecosystems.

Guests are invited to visit Earth Lab to reconnect with the natural world and learn some simple life-hacks that will allow them to make a difference. There are functioning camel stables with an arena and grooming area and from where early morning and twilight camel rides set out.

This extraordinary desert setting presents a host of activities for guests who choose to be out and about. Within the resort is Grow With Six Senses, a dedicated kid's hangout for younger guests who may not be joining their parent's adventures.

The Arava Valley and the surrounding region features several historic, archaeological and nature landmarks together with the opportunity to participate in extreme sports such as off-road driving, mountain climbing, mountain biking and rappelling.

More leisurely family-inclusive activities are hiking, camel or jeep safaris, craft workshops, bird watching and wine tours.

Eilat, which is located on the Red Sea, is ideal for families. A 60-minute drive from Shaharut, the resort town features calm waters, abundant sea life and excellent snorkeling and diving.

Camel camping overnights are arranged with flair and comfort, while dune walking with Bedouins includes fascinating story telling and desert lore.

Trips further afield can be arranged to Petra, Masada, Mount Karkom and the Dead Sea.

## SIX SENSES SPA

Six Senses Spa Shaharut includes four single and two double treatment rooms, male and female saunas and hammams. In addition to the menu of Six Senses Specialty treatments, several traditional therapies are offered together with Six Senses Integrated Wellness, which is based on the preventative principles of Eastern medicine and result-oriented Western influences.

Six Senses Spa also offers a 262-foot (18-meter) indoor pool, 80-foot (25-meter) outdoor lap pool, full-equipped gym and yoga studio with desert views. There is a nail bar for manicures and pedicures and the perfect spot to enjoy a chilled glass of wine.

An Alchemy Bar and Juice Bar are on hand for those looking for an energy boost.

## HOW TO GET THERE

The journey to Shaharut is part of the story, traveling through the timeless landscape steeped in history. A comfortable transfer can be arranged through the resort, with the drive from Tel Aviv or Jerusalem taking around three-and-a-half hours, or three hours from Petra in neighboring Jordan. Various vehicle types can be reserved through the resort.

Flights from Tel Aviv to Eilat are 50 minutes, followed by a 45-minute transfer to the resort from new international airport, Ramon. This new airport serves domestic flights and major carriers from key European markets.

Helicopter flights from Tel Aviv to Shaharut are available and must be booked in advance.
