Overview

Perched on Lake Atitlán overlooking three breathtaking volcanoes, Casa Palopó is a soulful family-owned hideaway in Guatemala. Once a private home, the lakeside hideaway opened its doors as a boutique hotel in 2000. While the property has flourished since then, the warm, intimate feeling of a private home remains to this day.

The first Relais & Chateaux in the country, Casa Palopó offers 12 individually designed accommodations plus a three-suite villa accented with contemporary indigenous Guatemalan artwork and private terraces to take in the stunning lake views. Immerse yourself in the country's rich culture by dining at 6.8 Palopó for Guatemalan-inspired dishes, cruising on Lake Atitlan, exploring the country through unique excursions, or meeting with a Shaman for ancient Mayan rituals.

Casa Palopó also offers a traditional Antiguan three-bedroom home in Antigua, the former capital of Guatemala and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This home is the perfect stopover for guests traveling to and from Casa Palopó.

How to Get There

Casa Palopó is set on Lake Atitlán in Guatemala known as one of the most beautiful lakes in the world. The property is approximately 75 miles away from La Aurora International Airport in Guatemala City.

There is a helipad located on property with the coordinates of N14°42.99 W091°07.87.

November-April is the best time to visit during Guatemala's dry season.

Accommodations

Casa Palopó offers 12 individually designed accommodations plus a three-suite villa accented with contemporary indigenous Guatemalan artwork and private terraces to take in the stunning lake views. Each of the rooms and suites is unique, with stucco walls painted in rich colors like Moroccan blue and Terracotta and decorated with indigenous artwork. Exposed wooden beams add warmth, while Italian linens bring light.

Deluxe (5) - 160-315 square feet *King or Queen Beds*

Set in the main house, the Deluxe rooms offer direct views of Lake Atitlán and the pool from the balcony.

Superior (1) - 279 square feet *King Bed*

Located near the pool area, the Superior room is located on the first floor and offers a view of Lake Atitlán from the balcony.

Junior Suite (2) - 215-275 square feet *King Bed*

Located in the Main House and pool area, the Junior Suites are spacious and offer direct views of Lake Atitlán.

Suite (3) - 473-515 square feet *King Bed*

Set in the Main House, the suites are spacious and offer sweeping views of Lake Atitlán from the balcony. An extra bed can be accommodated in the Santa Clara Suite.

La Villa (1)

Three suites located in La Villa, a second building that's 150 steps up from the main house. These bedrooms can be booked individually or taken over as a private villa. More contemporary in style, La Villa's suites offer modern artwork, warm woods, and bathtubs that overlook the lake. Guests taking over La Villa will have private access to a large living room with panoramic lake views, a fireplace, terraces, and a full kitchen where the chef and butler can prepare meals. The villa also has its own infinity pool and hot tub with lake views, a gazebo, and an outdoor fireplace for settling in under the stars at night.



Dining

6.8 Palopó Restaurant

Immerse yourself in the country's rich culture by dining at 6.8 Palopó for Guatemalan-inspired dishes made with ingredients sourced from local farms. Dine al fresco on the terrace overlooking breathtaking lake views. The restaurant offers indoor dining with its jaunty yet elegant interiors accented with colorful candlelit chandeliers, wicker chairs, and white tablecloths. Guests can also dine al fresco on the terrace overlooking breathtaking lake views.



Breakfast might be a local dish of fried eggs, black beans, and plantains. Dinner could have a fusion flare, like cannelloni filled with hilachas, the traditional Guatemalan beef stew.

Casa Palopó's serene setting overlooking Lake Atitlán is a place of relaxation. Its intimate spa offers tailored massages and spa treatments inspired by ancient Guatemalan rituals.
