Mustang Monument is the passion project of Madeleine Pickens, an American businesswoman and philanthropist, who initiated a personal mission to protect and preserve nearly 1,000 wild mustangs and help share their story through the launch of her non-profit foundation, Saving America's Mustangs. Now, guests of the ranch can continue to tell this story as they meet these magnificent animals face to face in their natural habitat.

At the heart of Mustang Monument is a desire to bring adventure travelers closer to America's iconic Western culture and heritage in the wide-open plains of northern Nevada. This exclusive-use ranch houses 10 cozy cottages and a Western chic seven-bedroom home. Embodying an unbridled passion for the environment, Mustang Monument is a place to reconnect with nature. This ranch estate is designed for special celebrations and meaningful events where activities are curated and customized to guests' preferences.

How to Get There

Mustang Monument is set on 900 square miles of wide-open plains in the Northwest corner of Nevada in the town of Wells.

Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC)
Transfer time approximately 2.5 hours by car

Elko Regional Airport (EKO) *Private Aircraft Only*
Transfer time approximately 50 minutes by car

Wells Municipal Airport/Harriet Field (LWL) *Small Private Aircraft Only*
Transfer time approximately 25 minutes by car

Helicopter transfers available upon request

Accommodations

Luxury Cottages (10)

Glamping with a western flair, the luxury cottages, spanning 550 sq. ft., are individually designed, spacious and well-appointed. Each cottage offers an open floor plan with plush king bed, outdoor deck and seating area, heat, air conditioning, walk in closet, and roomy bathroom with a separate soaking tub, shower and dual vanity sinks.

Seven-Bedroom Home (1)

This two-story pioneer house is a mix of traditional and contemporary elements complete with small kitchen, living room, dining room and front porch. The seven bedrooms are comprised of four (4) king rooms, one (1) queen room and two (2) rooms with one (1) bunk bed each.

Rates: \$2,600.00 ++ (exclusive of tax) per night for exclusive use of the ranch. Pricing is based on double occupancy for the 10 luxury cottages only. The seven-bedroom home is available for groups and buy-outs, and the pricing will be provided upon request.

At Ruby’s, enjoy cocktails from celebrated mixologists accompanied by delectable hors d’oeuvres before sitting down to an expertly crafted multi-course dinner paired with fine wines. Everything at Ruby’s Restaurant is made in-house exemplifying the culinary team’s passion and love for cooking.

Guests can also sharpen their own knife skills cooking side-by-side with the chefs during cooking classes held in their state-of-the-art kitchen.



Tommy’s Saloon is the perfect place to kick your boots up after a robust day of adventure. Enjoy a cocktail around the fire pit, engage in a little friendly competition with a variety of games including ping pong and corn hole, or just take in the breathtaking view of a star filled sky.
